This is with reference to the proposal submitted by Guru Nanak Institute of Technology, Khanapur, Ibrahimpatnam, R.R. Dist. Telanagna-501 506 affiliated to JNT University, Hyderabad under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 16 12.2020, the Competent Authority has decided to grant autonomous status to Guru Nanak Institute of Technology, Khanapur, Ibrahimpatnam, R.R. Dist. Telanagna-501 506 affiliated to JNT University, Hyderabad for a period of Ten (10) years from the session 2020-2021 to 2029-2030 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.4 (i) of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding the grant of autonomous status to the college as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The college, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. The college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the UGC has conferred Autonomous Status to Guru Nanak Institute of Technology, Khanapur (V), Manchal (M), Ibrahimpatnam, R.R.(Dist), Telangana State, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, Telangana under the UGC scheme for Autonomous Colleges for a period of Ten Years from the Academic Year 2020-21 to 2029-30 and requested the University to issue conferment orders as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations 2018 for Autonomous Colleges.

Also, the UGC has stated that the autonomy granted colleges shall abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The college shall apply, in the prescribed format to the UGC, for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

Further, it is to inform that the College is permitted to follow existing University syllabus & regulations for the first year batch of Academic Year 2020-21 and autonomous syllabus from Second year onwards for the Academic Year 2020-21 admitted students only. Also informed that the admitted batches from the Academic Year 2017-18 to 2019-20, have to follow JNTUH Affiliated Colleges Regulations and Syllabus.
