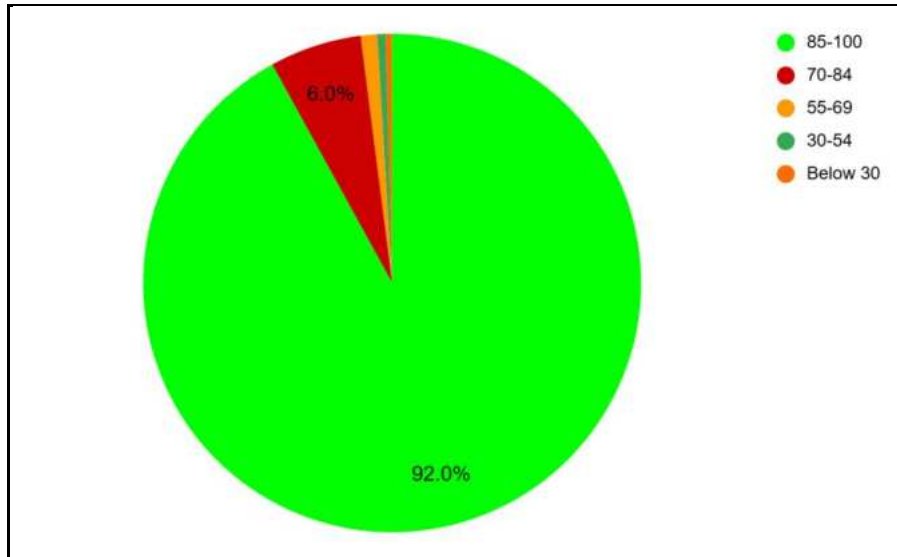

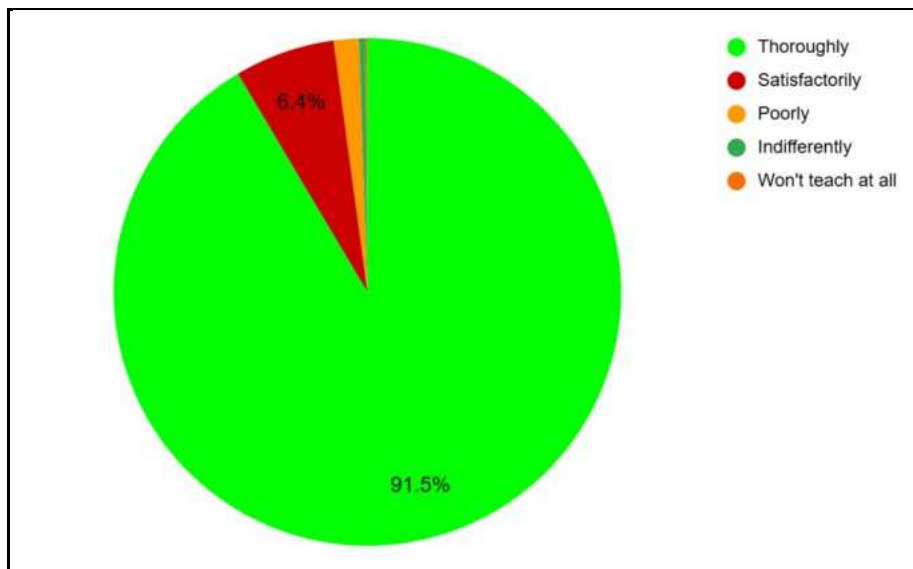

1. How much percentage of Syllabus covered in the class?

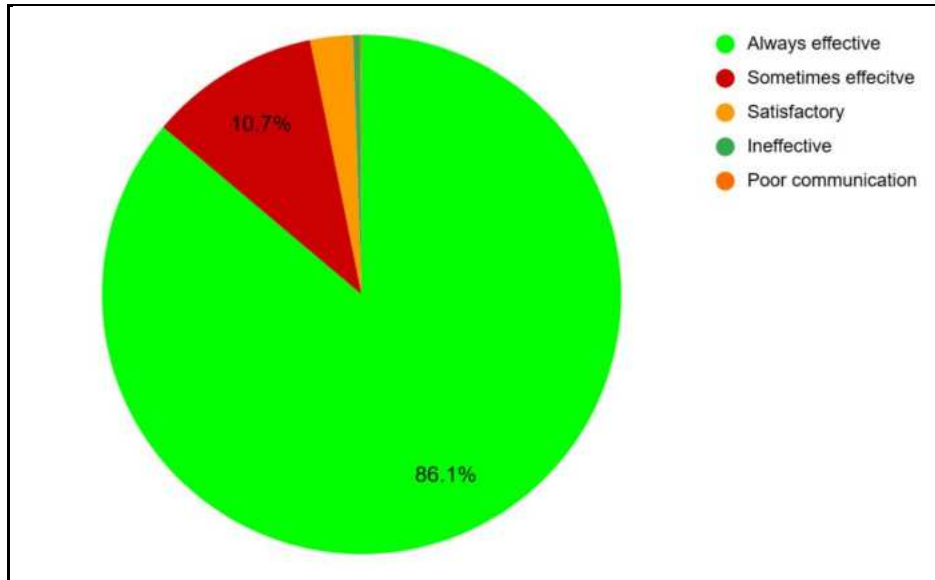


2. Can you notice how well teacher prepared for the class

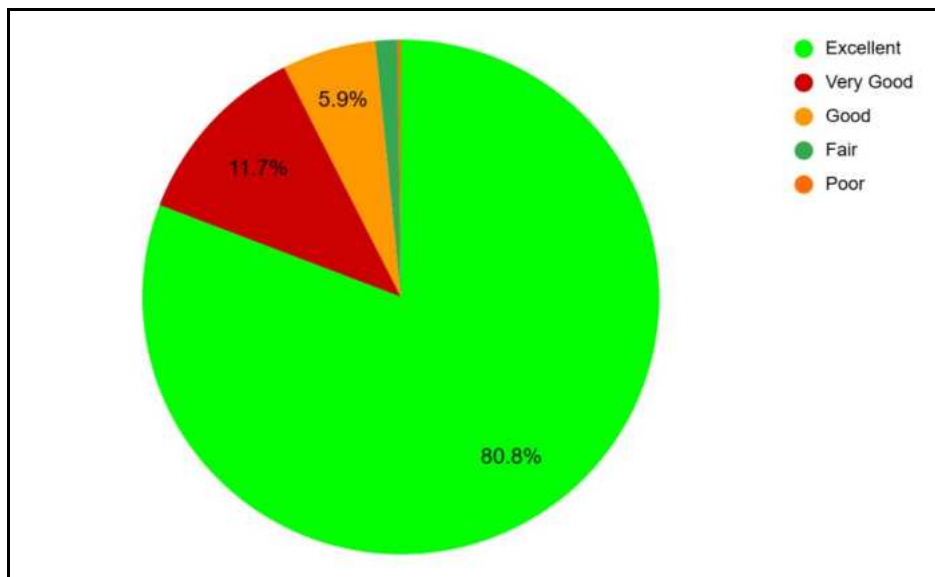

3. How well were teachers able to communicate?

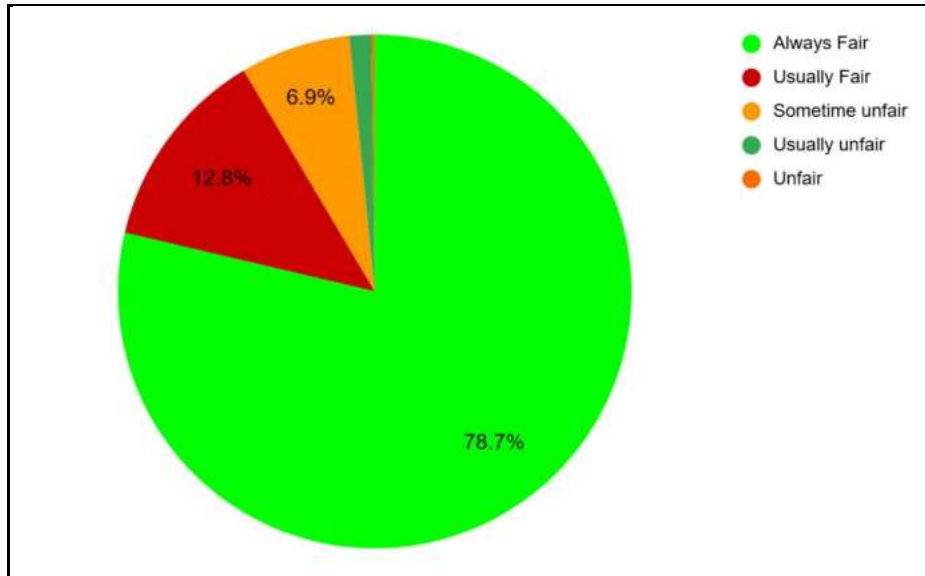


4. The teachers can be best rated as

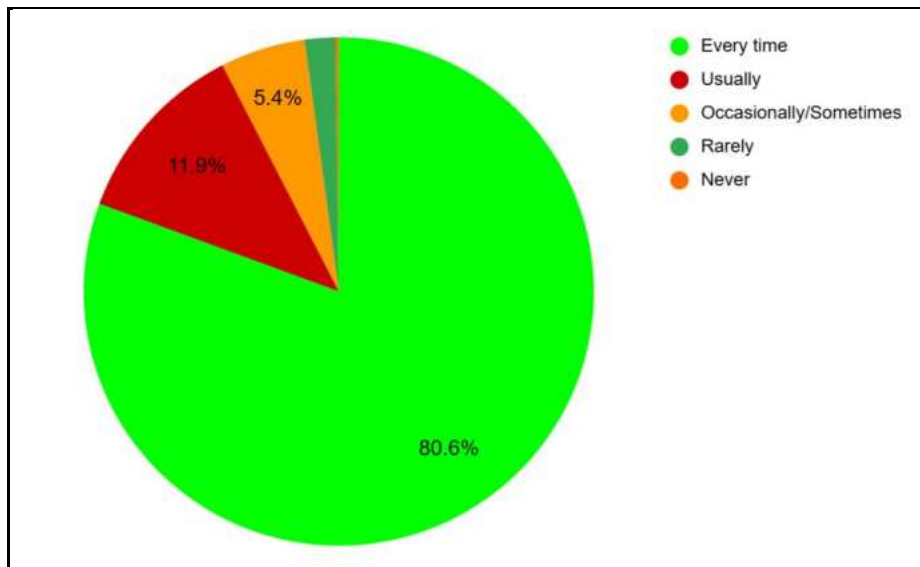

5. Internal evaluation by teachers.

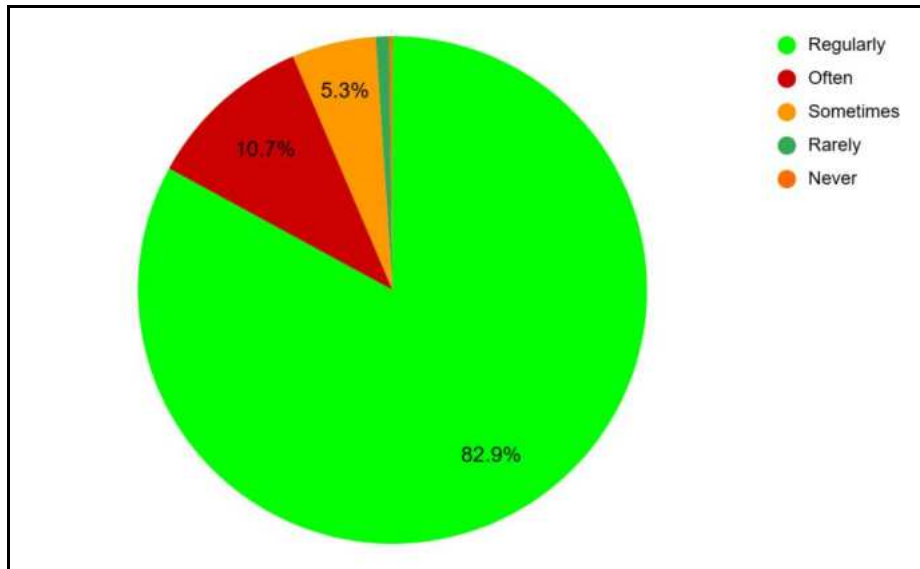


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

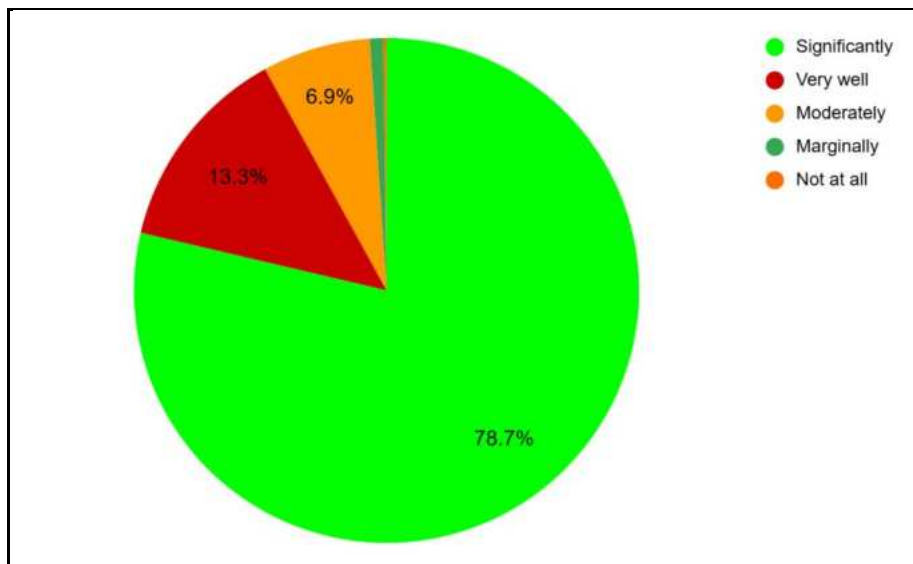

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students

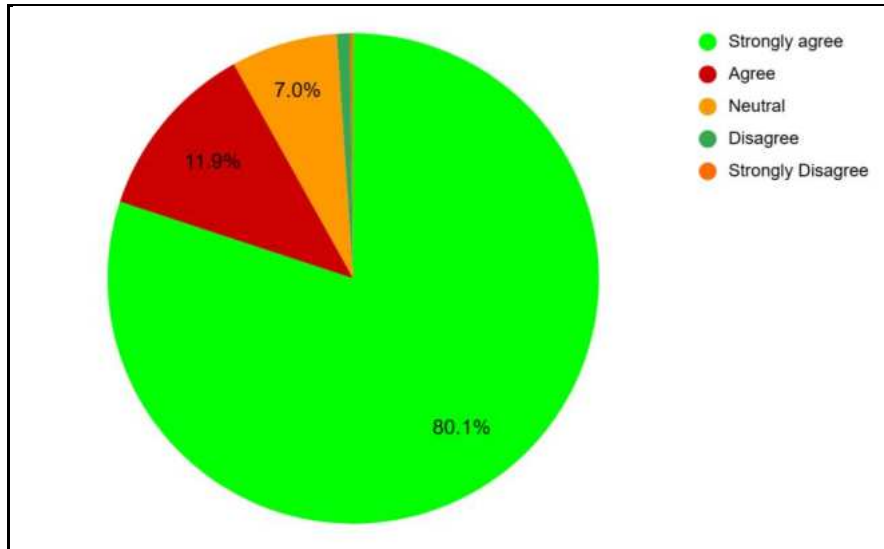


8. The teaching and mentoring process facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

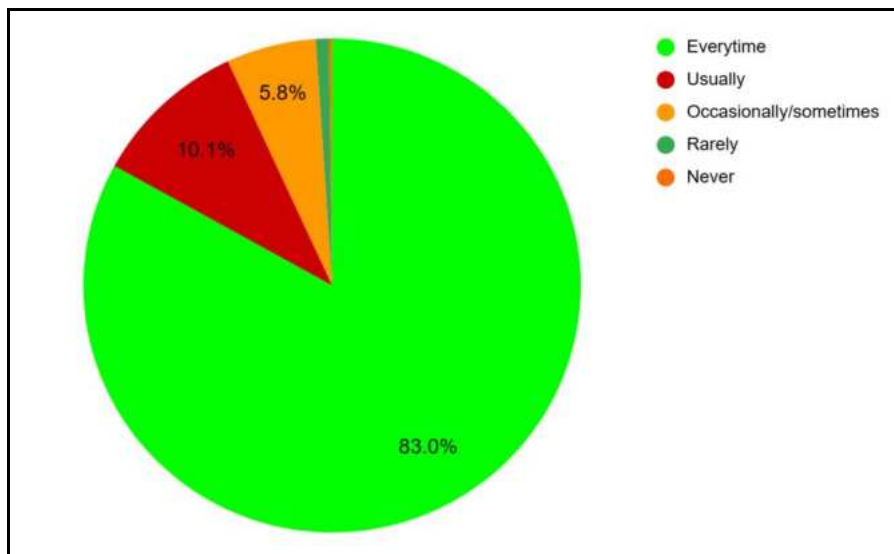

9. Do you feel that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow?

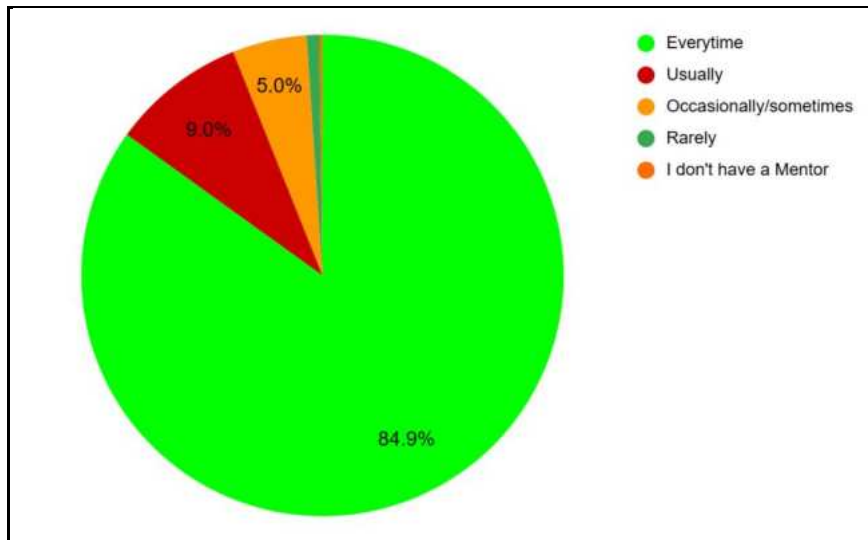


10. Whether teachers inform you about expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes?

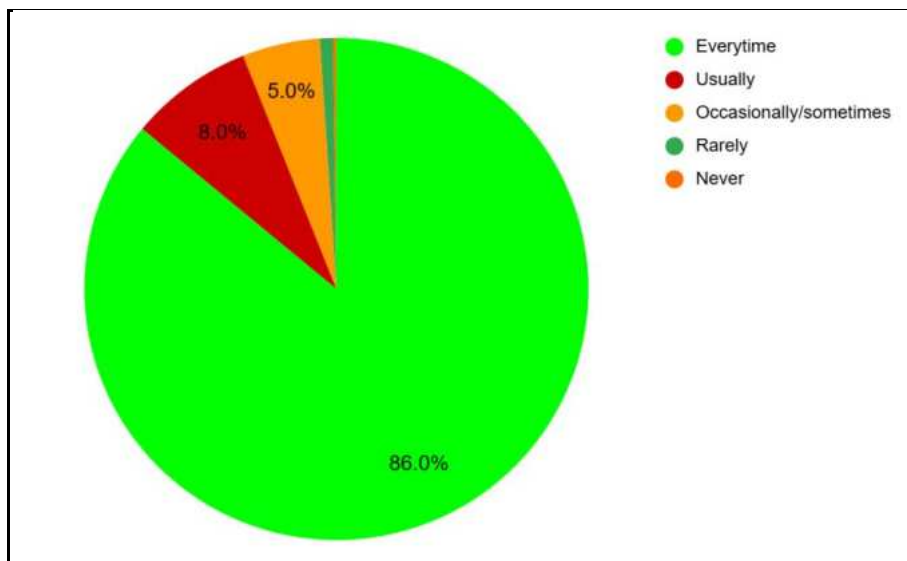

11. Whether your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you?

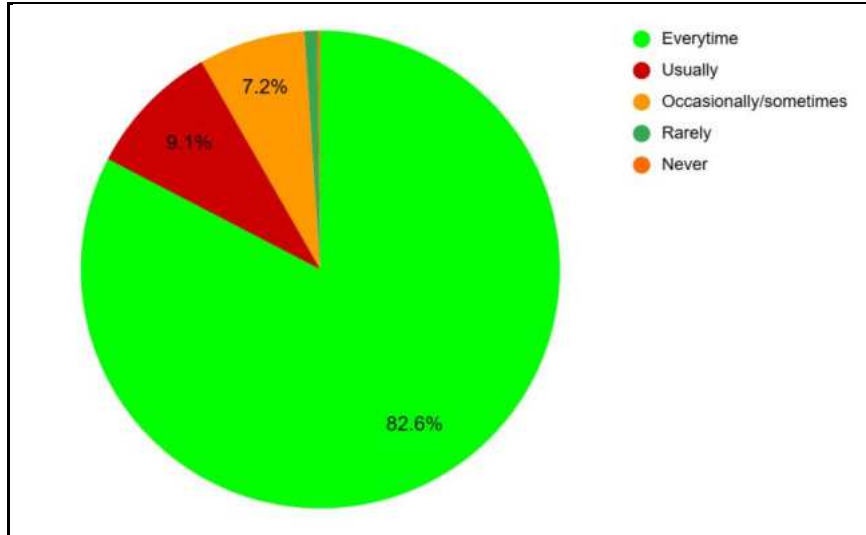


12. Whether the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications?

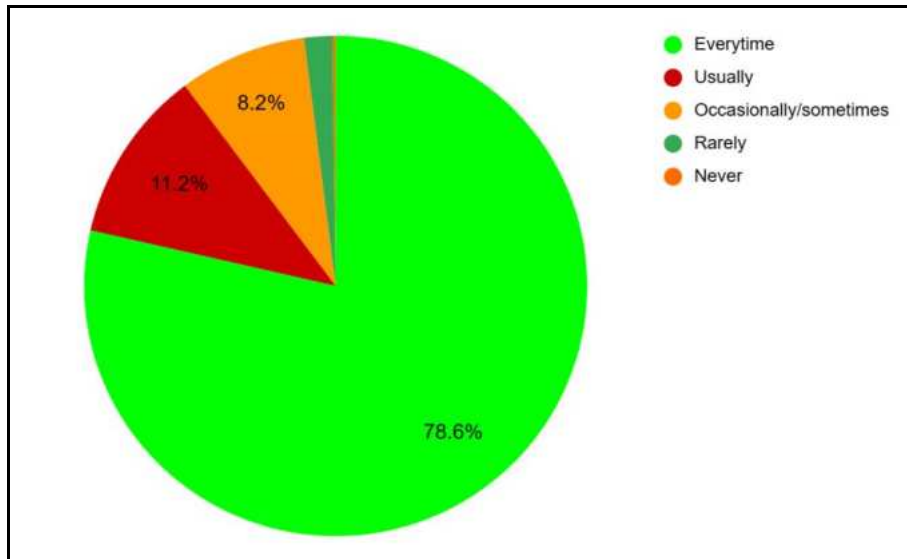

13. Whether teachers identify your strength and encourage to groom you with providing right level of challenges?

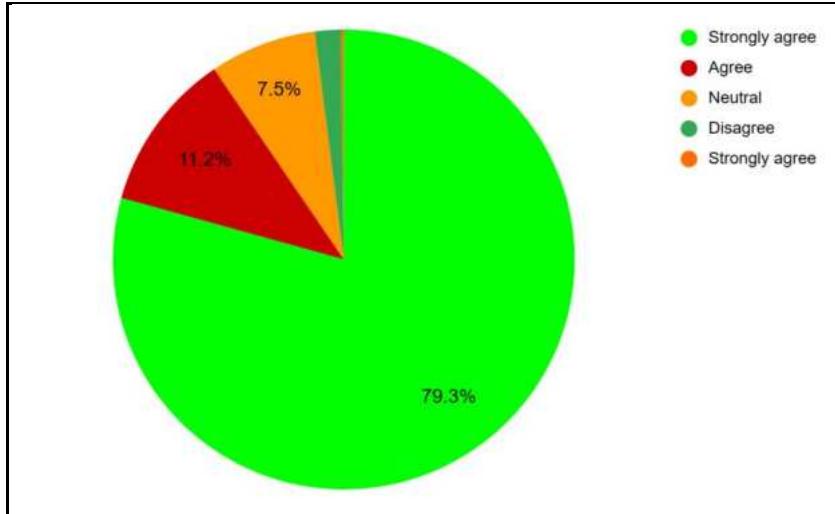


14. Whether teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome?

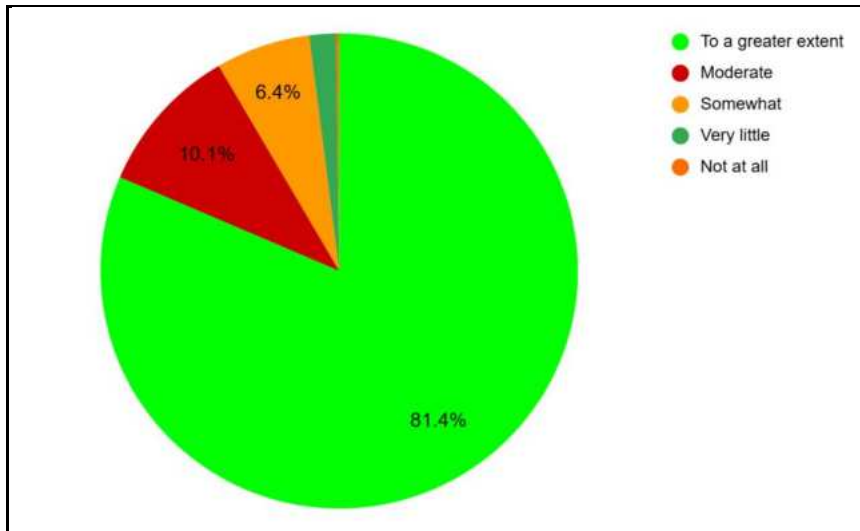

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process

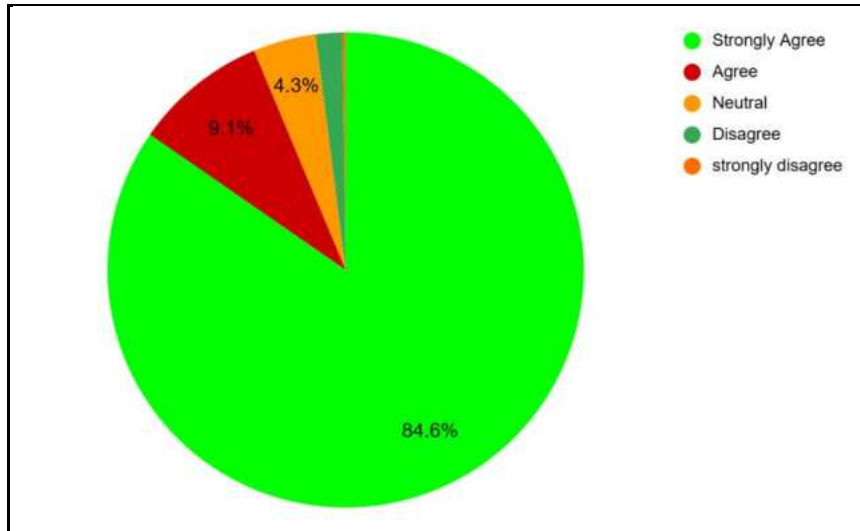


16. The institute/teachers using student-centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences

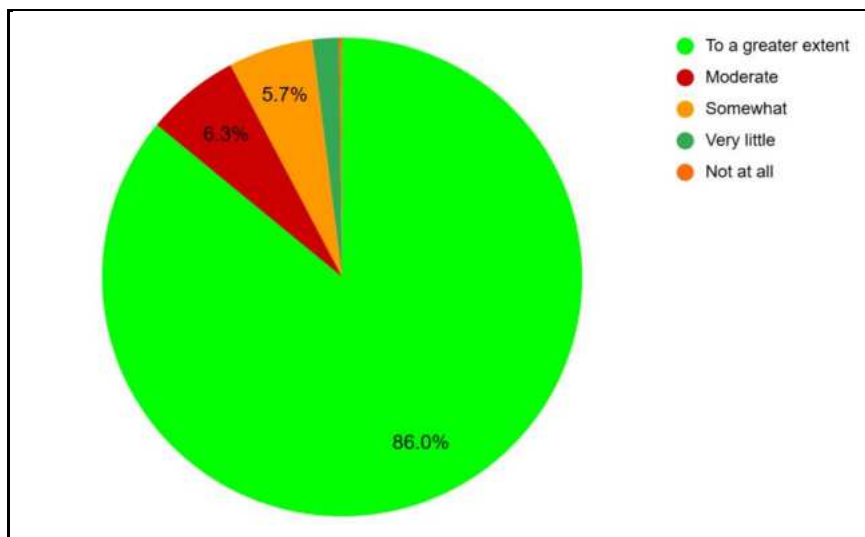

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

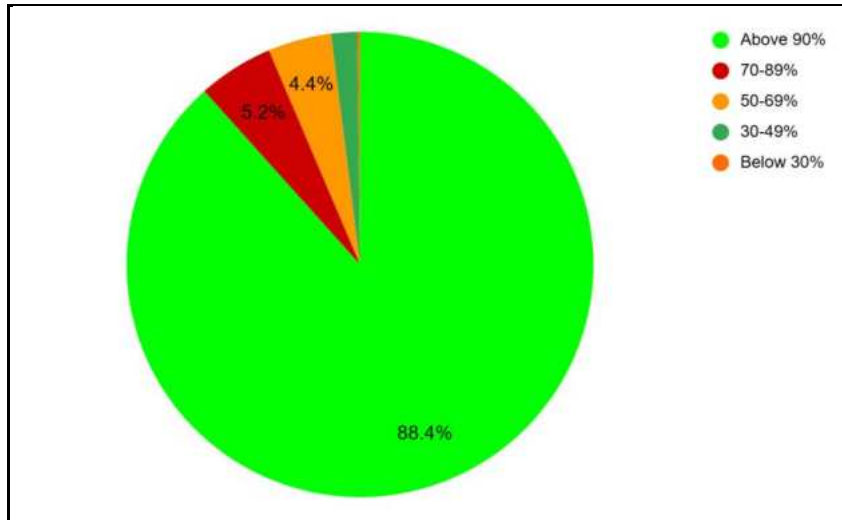


18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work

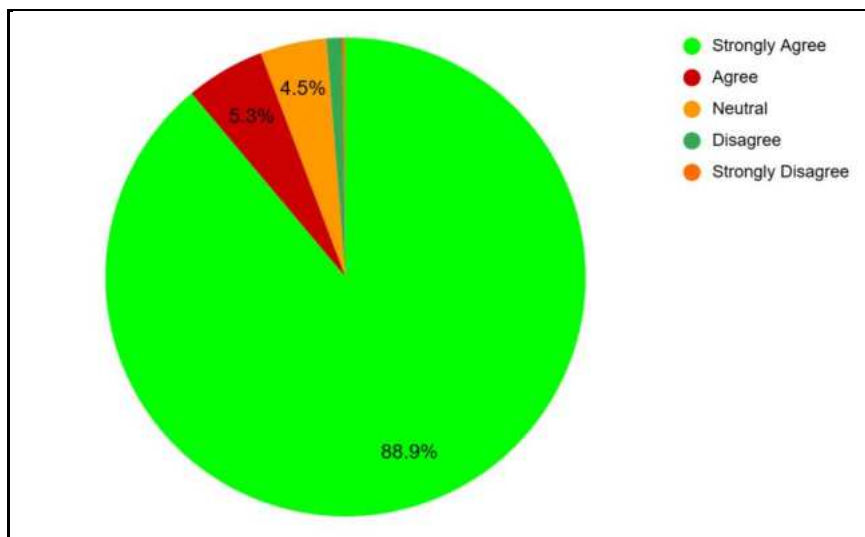
