Minutes of the Governing Body Meeting

The meeting was started with the welcome address by the Chairman of the Governing Body, Dr. H. S. Saini. The Member Secretary presented a PPT presentation on the progress of academics, research activities, accreditations, placements, newly added infrastructure and the increase and reduction of the student's intake.

The following points were discussed and resolved as follows.

1. Faculty strength and recruitments and addition of Ph. Ds.

Resolution: Members appreciated the initiative taken by the institution to recruit more number of Ph D holders to strengthen the research and academics. They also suggested adding some more Ph Ds in departments like CSE and ECE.

2. Increase / Reduction of intake: The principal explained to the members about the demand in the emerging areas and requested the members to accord permission to increase the intake. Also, he explained to the members that the intake in Mechanical and Civil Engineering shall be reduced as the admissions are less. However, the Principal informed the members that the existing faculty members will be retained and they will be accommodated in various departments.

The details are as follows:

Increase in Intake:

- a. Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning)
CSM: 60 to 120 seats (Course started in 2020)
- b. Artificial Intelligence and Data Science – AID: 60 to 120 seats (Course started in 2021)

Reduction in Intake:

- a. Mechanical Engineering: 120 to 60 seats
- b. Civil engineering 120 to 60 seats

Resolution: (a) Members approved the increase in intake in Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning) and Artificial Intelligence and Data Science – from the present intake of 60 to 120 seats

(b) Members approved the reduction in the intake of Mechanical and Civil Engineering from the present intake of 120 to 60 seats.

Members appreciated the institution for retaining the faculty.

3. Infrastructure: The principal informed to the members that an additional new block has been added with a built-up area of 8856 Sq ft to accommodate the new specializations and their laboratories for A.Y. 2022-23

Resolutions: Members appreciated the efforts and initiation taken by the institution.

4. Research Activities: The principal presented the details of the Centers of Excellence, Patents, Publications and IIC activities, Students involvement & Achievements and the further activities in the pipeline.

Resolution: Members appreciated the vision of the institution to develop the students & faculty members with the research motto and they exclusively appreciated achieving the IIC star rating maximum.

5. Accreditations: The principal presented the status of the NBA.

Resolution: The Department of Information Technology (IT) - GNIT submitted the NBA- SAR on 05-02-2022 and waiting for the inspection schedule.

6. Placements: Placements: The Members are briefed about the pre-placement activities for the second and third-year students to improve employability skills. The registered students are also offered training to improve their technical skills which incurred expenditure. The members are also informed about the placement drives, companies visited and 535 students got selected in various companies till date and waiting for other companies to visit basing on the schedule.
