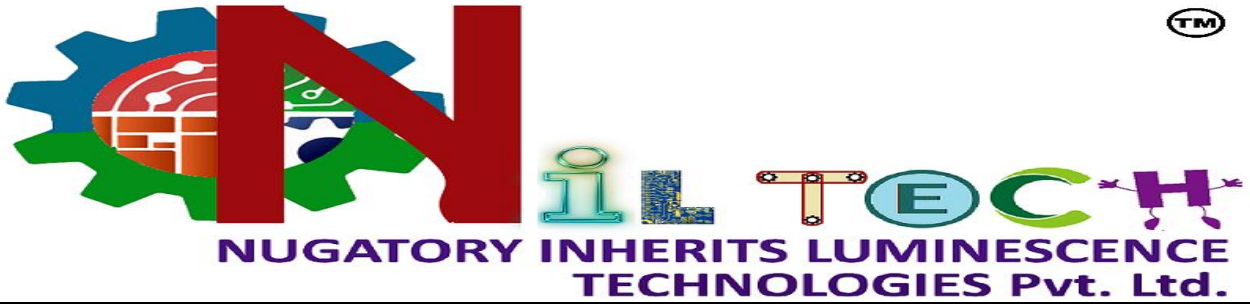

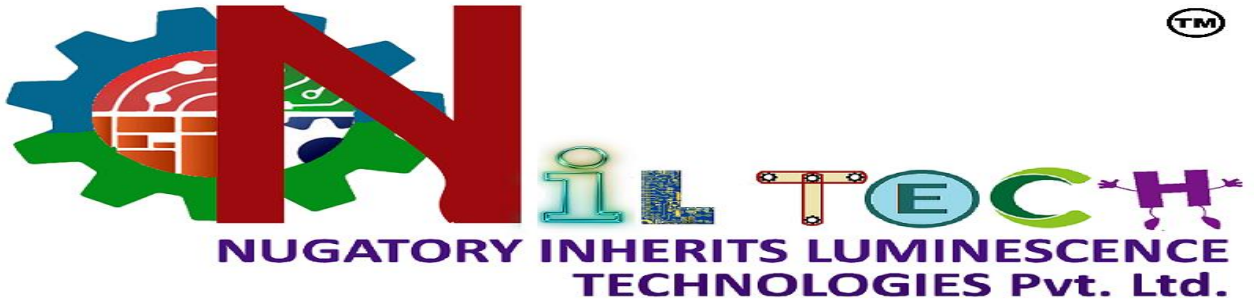


#### IV. General Instructions

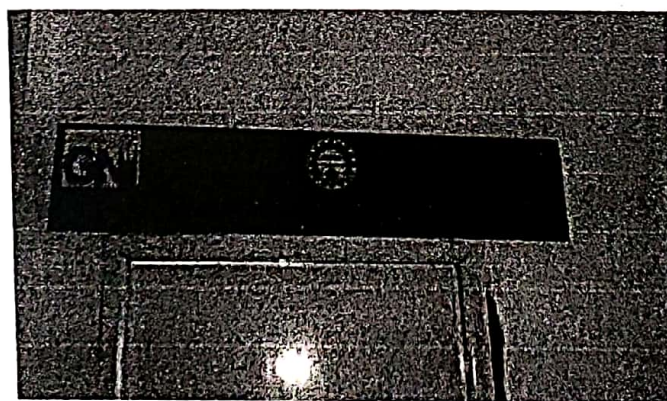
